All working papers must be in the following order:

Committee:

Full name of the committee (no abbreviations)

Sponsors:

The sponsors in a resolution paper are the countries that voted in favor of this document. All resolution papers must have five sponsors, these being the primary authors of the paper. The whole committee votes for the five sponsors.

Title:

Complete title of the problematic the committee is debating about.

Preambulatory Clauses:

The preambulatory clauses state the issue. In this section of the resolution paper, delegates must express why they felt the need to solve the given problematic in such way. They can give specific details about the matter.

Operative Clauses:

The operative clauses give a clear explanation of what the committee decided to do. As mentioned before, this section may include organizations, international laws, protocols, and policies. Proposals can't go against human rights, violate international laws, suggest war, disrupt peace, etc.
